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



Uses: Tarpon and Saltwater Patterns, Salmon, Pike, Musky and Bass Flies, and also Tube Flies





Model perfect bend, oversized down-eye, 1X-fine wire, "mini-barb"


Uses: Standard Dry Flies



Short-Bodied Dry Flies




### 1480 (Bronze)

Limerick bend, straight-eye, 1X-fine wire, 2X-short shank, "mini-barb"

Uses: Midges, Spiders, Variants



Sproat bend, down-eye, 3X-short shank Uses: Egg Patterns, Spiders, Ants

Sproat bend, down-eye, 2X-heavy wire, 1X-short shank


Uses: Short-Bodied Wet Flies, Nymphs, Steelhead Flies



Sproat bend, down-eye, 1X-heavy wire, 1X-long shank


Uses: Wet Flies, Traditional Nymphs

Round bend, down-eye, 1X-heavy wire, 2X-long shank, forged


Uses: Wet Flies, Standard Nymph Patterns, Muddlers, Hoppers

Continuous bend, down-eye, 2X-heavy wire, 1X-short shank, forged, reversed


Uses: Scud, Shrimp, Grubs, Pupae, San Juan Worms, Nymphs

Round bend, straight-eye, 1X-heavy wire, 4X-long shank, forged


Uses: Muddlers, Streamers, Zonkers, Bucktails

Round bend, down-eye, 1X-heavy wire, 4X-long shank, forged


Uses: Streamers, Muddlers, Woolly Buggers, Zonkers, Bucktails






#### 1120 (Bronze)

Continuous bend, down-eye, 2X-heavy wire, 1X-short shank, forged, reversed




Continuous bend, down-eye, 1X-fine wire, 1X-short shank, forged, reversed


Continuous bend, up-eye, 1X-fine wire, 1X-short shank, forged, reversed

Curved shank, wide gape, slightly heavy wire, straight-eye

Uses: Klinkhamers, Emergers, Caseless Caddis Nymphs and Gammarus Patterns




Barbless, Heavy Wire, Czech Style




#### 1760 (Bronze)

Round bend, down-eye, 2x-heavy wire, 2x-long, curved shank, forged

Uses: Flies for steelhead, salmon and large trout




**4250 (Bronze) 4253 (Red) 4255 (Gold)**Standard egg hook, no slice on shank, reversed




#### 1260 (Bronze)

Round bend, straight-eye, curved shank Uses: Bead Head Nymphs, Hoppers, Terrestrials. Easy to use with beads of all types.



**1270 (Bronze) 1273 (Red) (8–22)** York bend, straight-eye, 3X-long shank, forged Uses: Hoppers, Terrestrials, Stoneflies, Nymphs, Midges




#### 2581 (Black Nickel)

Round bend, heavy wire, short shank, beak bend, widegape, reversed

Uses: Multi-use hook for large trout, salmon, etc.






#### 2553 (Red) (all sizes) 2557 (Black Nickel) (sizes 6 - 1)


Beak bend, wide-gape, up-eye, forged, reversed

Uses: Saltwater and Salmon Flies. Sizes 6-1 are common for Intruder and Stinger flies, trailing hooks



#### 1730 (Bronze)


Round bend, down-eye, bent down shank, 1X-heavy wire, 3X-long shank, forged Uses: Stonefly Nymphs, Crab Patterns



#### 1870 (Bronze)


York bend, up-eye, 3X-long shank, 2X-heavy wire

Uses: Swimming Nymphs and Larval Insect Patterns



#### 1770 (Bronze)


Sproat bend, straight-eye, 1X-fine wire, 3X-long curved shank, forged Uses: Swimming Nymphs, Leeches, San Juan Worms




#### 2720 (Bronze)

Wide-gape bend, straight eye, 1X-fine wire Uses: Deer Hair Bass Bugs, Divers, Frogs, Mice




**2141 (Black)** Limerick bend, tapered loop eye, 1X-heavy wire, forged






**2421 (Black)**Tapered-loop up-eye, forged

Uses: Bottom Searching Steelhead Flies




**2161 (Black)**Curved shank, tapered-loop up-eye, forged
Uses: Salmon/Steelhead Flies and Nymphs




Wide-gape, Limerick bend, medium wire, down-eye, forged

Uses: Bombers and other flies for salmon, steelhead, bass or large trout




**7131 (Black)**Limerick bend, loop up-eye, forged

Round bend, standard wire, 90° bend, flat eye Uses: Jigs, Flies for float fishing




4690 (Matte Bronze) 4695 (Matte Brown) 4699 (Matte Black) 4694 (Matte Green) 4698 (Matte Grey)




#### 4640 (Bronze) 4647 (Black Nickel)

Limerick bend, heavy wire, long shank, bent 60 degrees, flat eye, forged.


**Uses**: Jigs and flies for float fishing, or fly fishing with a float.

# SALTWATER HOOKS



#### 3111 (Black)

O'Shaughnessy bend, beak point, 2X-short shank, straight-eye, forged, reversed Uses: Saltwater, Salmon and Steelhead Flies



#### 2546 (Stainless Steel)

O'Shaughnessy bend, straight eye, forged, stainless steel, ground needle point Uses: Salt Water Fly Patterns. Size 8 commonly used for Crab & Shrimp Patterns
